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Please refer to the current PGMHA Policy Manual for all AP related policy. The affiliated player has to be approved by BC Hockey with fees paid in full, prior to attending a game and/or practice.

- ❖ The PGMHA Office will hold the original copy of the Player Affiliation Permission Form.
- ❖ When a coach wants to affiliate a player, the coach must have a signed permission form from the players regular team coach as well as the parents of the player **prior** to the player being added to the team's affiliation list. This is the responsibility of the team doing the affiliating.
- ❖ When a coach wants to use an affiliate player, the coach must inform the regular team coach and get approval from the Rep Supervisor, before asking the player to come up.
- ❖ Teams may affiliate with any player who is from a team in a lower category in the **same** division. eg.: U15 Tier 1 may pull from U15 Tier 2, not U15 recreational. U15 Tier 2 pulls from U15 recreational T1, etc. They may not pull from outside their division (Exception for female teams if there is only one team per division) .
- ❖ Affiliated players must be registered with PGMHA and have played at least one game with their regular season team if they are coming from a recreational team.
- ❖ Affiliated players are to be used to **replace** an injured or absent player in a game(s)
- ❖ Affiliated players must actually play in a game that they have been called up for.
- ❖ Affiliated players **must** return to regular season team once assignment is completed.
- ❖ An affiliated player must be identified on the game sheet as "AP"
- ❖ An affiliate player must have their affiliate fees paid in full
- ❖ Each time my child is used as an affiliate player he/she must return to his/her regular season team.
- ❖ My child is only permitted to play **ten** games as an AP.
- ❖ League and playoff games for the player's regular team are always their first priority.

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## AFFILIATION HISTORY RECORD

THIS PLAYER CAN ONLY PLAY IN TEN GAMES AS AN AFFILIATE PLAYER. ONCE HIS REGULAR TEAM HAS COMPLETED THEIR COMMITMENTS, FOR THE ENTIRE SEASON, THIS PLAYER CAN THEN PLAY ADDITIONAL GAMES FOR THE TEAM HE IS AFFILIATING WITH (HOCKEY CANADA RULE E 35.a.). THE APPEARANCE OF THE REGISTERED PLAYERS NAME ON THE OFFICIAL GAME SHEET SHALL BE CONSIDERD PARTICIPATION IN THAT GAME.  
COACHES MUST NOTIFY THE LEAGUE WITHIN 3 DAYS (72HRS.)

ALL PRINCE GEORGE MINOR HOCKEY REP TEAMS ARE MEMBERS OF THE CARIBOO LEAGUE SO MUST ADHERE TO THE CARIBOO RULE 2.9 WHICH STATES THAT ALL GAMES INCLUDING EXHIBITION , LEAGUE, TOURNAMENT OR PLAYOFF WILL COUNT AS GAMES PLAYED FOR THE AFFILIATION RULE.
